

Part 2

Pattern Repeats

In part one, we worked with knitting charts that showed every knitting operation on every row. But many knitting charts don't do so. One such type of chart shows only a small segment of a project, because that small segment gets repeated over and over.

In this part, we'll first see how we work from such a chart, then we'll learn to chart instructions with these repeated sections.

We'll work through the steps required to find such a segment hidden in written-out instructions, because once we find a stitch pattern's repeat, we can use it in any other project.

We'll also look at ways we can tweak a project chart, letting us customize projects almost any way we want to.

Finally, we'll see how we can turn a single motif into a stitch pattern that can be repeated across the entire fabric.
