It always gets great comments.

The pattern was tricky getting started, so I cheated by working three rows flat, then putting all the stitches on a sixty-inch Knit Picks interchangeable cable and laid it flat on my table to make sure it wasn't twisted when I joined to work in the round.

It isn't hard to work a swirl, but it does take some good record keeping to stay on track. I made a 3-page chart with the instructions for each welt, then I checked off each round of each welt as I finished it.
