Seamless Set-In Sleeve



Pattern: Seamless Set-In Sleeve Sweater by Elizabeth Zimmermann Source: *Knitting Workshop*, Original Edition Yarn: Knit Picks Wool of the Andes Worsted, 7.5 skeins, 372 g Gauge: 21 sts and 24 rows = 4 in Finished: 2009

Tags: seamless, crew-neck, set-in-sleeves, bottom-up

Notes

No more set-in sleeves, seamless or seamed!

Oh, and I made it too short. Sigh. Instead of giving it to someone, I decide to lengthen it. As you know, if there's any kind of texture or colorwork pattern, you **cannot** work downward on a piece worked upward, because the pattern will be off half a stitch.

So I snipped a row midway between cable crossings, raveled the round, added some length to the bottom, then



grafted the whole thing back together. There are so many ends woven in because the grafting yarn got ratty looking so quickly, so lots of fresh lengths.



But the graft looks pretty good.



Note to self: Never again. (That would be both lengthening/shortening garments with stitch patterns **and** doing set-in sleeves.)
